Other Business

Mike G. reported that the GLQO purchased a Dissolved Oxygen (DO) meter to measure DO in Gull Lake and Little Long Lake this summer, since the CLMP program is unable to provide a DO meter for 2020 sampliling. This summer, Mike (with additional help) will monitor water quality in Gull Lake and John E. will monitor water quality in Little Long Lake.

Mike G. discussed issues with the boat wash at Praireville Township park on Gull Lake that included electrical repairs and staffing. Steve K. offered to help Mike with the electrical repairs. Linda offered to follow up with Prairevill Township Park officials regarding staffing of the boat wash this summer.

Gregg P. asked about the status of the Gull Lake dam project and it was noted that that little new information is available beyond that fact that significant additional funds are needed. Kathy will check with Jeff P. to see about putting a dam update in the spring GLQO newsletter

Mike G. mentioned that he received a call from Mark Allen about a culvert that drains water from Miller Lake into Gull Lake. It was noted that considerable water flows through this culvert and that this flow is important in regulating the water level of Miller Lake.
