

GLQO BOAT WASH ATTENDANT JOB DESCRIPTION

General Description:

Under the supervision of the Boat wash coordinator and Gull Lake Quality Organization (GLQO) liaison, attendants will inspect watercraft entering (as needed) and leaving Gull Lake and assist with washing (decontamination) to assure watercraft and trailers are free of aquatic invasive plant species.

Essential Functions:

The essential functions include, but are not limited to:

- Performs all watercraft inspection and washing (decontamination) procedures as specified in the “Training Handbook.”
- Completes and submits biweekly time sheets in a timely manner.
- Complies with the requirement of Prairieville Township as detailed in their “Policies and Procedures” Handbook
- Assists with other functions as assigned by GLQO staff.

Minimum Qualifications/Skills Required

- Personable and pleasant – able to communicate well with boaters and others using the Boat Wash
- Works well with other attendants, GLQO and Prairieville Township staff
- Responsible and strong work ethic; maintains a well-groomed appearance and wears appropriate attire.
- Possess a working knowledge – or the ability to learn - about aquatic invasive species and the need for their control.
- Must have a valid driver’s license or school ID and a social security card.
- Can work independently with a minimum of supervision.
- Can read and comprehend all work-related documents and “Handbooks.”
- Can legibly complete reports and forms as require.
- Displays sound judgement regarding when to contact others for help (equipment failures, emergency situations, dangerous or unruly behavior)
- Responsible and responds in a positive manner to instructions and feedback from supervisor and GLQO staff

Hours and Payrate:

- Weekends (Friday-Sunday) and holidays; 10-15 hrs/week
- \$14-\$15/hr depending on experience
- Start and end dates negotiable; prefer late May-late August
