

## ***GLQO Boat Wash Coordinator...***

### ***Prairieville Township Park on Gull Lake***

The Gull Lake Quality Organization (GLQO) is seeking a Coordinator to oversee operations at the Boat Wash at Prairieville Township Park and assist with outreach activities to promote understanding of the factors affecting water quality in Gull Lake. The position is part-time 25-30 hours per week from mid-May through September (end date is negotiable).

***This position can also be developed into a paid internship*** with appropriate mentorship, training and educational experiences appropriate for undergraduates interested in Biology, Environmental Education, Ecology, Aquatic Sciences, Science Communication or related fields.

#### ***Key Responsibilities:***

- 1) Schedule, supervise and (as needed) train hourly employees (Boat wash Attendants) who will staff the boat wash, weekends and holidays. This may require covering an occasional shift or having a regularly scheduled shift early and late in the summer.
- 2) Help develop training materials for summer staff on operation of the boat wash.
- 3) Check on status of boat wash (weekly) and alert appropriate GLQO member(s) when maintenance or operational issues arise. Assist with minor repairs as appropriate.

#### ***Other Responsibilities (as needed or if interested)***

- 1) Assist GLQO members with monitoring water quality on Gull Lake and Little Long Lake.
- 2) Work with the GLQO to develop educational materials on control aquatic invasive species in inland lakes, including signs, brochures, and related print and digital materials.
- 3) Assist with the establishment and maintenance of native gardens and shoreline restoration projects at the Prairieville Township Park on Gull Lake

***Start/End Date:*** mid-May through mid-September, end date is negotiable.

***Hours:*** 20-25 hours per week, including some weekends

***Salary:*** \$20-\$25 per hour, depending on experience.

***Skill and Experiences:*** Strong interpersonal and communication skills; past supervisory experience (for scheduling staff); self-starter, organized and efficient worker; understanding or (or willingness to learn) about aquatic invasive species and their impacts aquatic ecosystems; experience in working and communicating with the public. Mechanical skills desired, but not required.
